

CASE STUDY. SCREENING BARREL REMOVAL - 2015

PROJECT: Removal of screening barrel

LOCATION: Blaise IVC Facility, West Malling, Kent

CLIENT: New Earth Solutions

CONTRACT DURATION: 2 weeks



Euro Demolition & Dismantling Ltd (EDD) were awarded the contact of removing a redundant green waste trommel screening barrel from within a live working facility located in West Malling, Kent.

This substantial screening unit weighing in at nearly 100 tons had to be decommissioned and dismantled with extra care being taken with regard to waste gases and the additional hazards of working within an enclosed and confined space.

In addition to monitoring the working practices within a confined area extra monitoring was introduced for the project with regard to gases. These gases were continually monitored and assessed to ensure site safety.

All disconnections had been prior arranged and carried out to enable safe access to the Barrel, surplus waste was removed from within and taken away from the working area, this waste was then used by the client in their day to day processes.

The barrel was then carefully dismantled and cut into sections where it was then lowered to ground level by mechanical excavator where further sizing was carried out. All recoverables were then loaded out to EDD accredited metal merchant. The site was then cleaned, swept and left in a tidy presentable condition for handover back to the client.
